

The Center for Human Potential and Public Policy 2008-9 Graduate Student Travel Awards

The Center for Human Potential and Public Policy is pleased to announce the availability of travel grants for Harris School graduate students.

Number and Timing of Awards:

The Center will award up to two, \$500 awards each quarter. The award must be used for travel to a conference during the quarter in which it is awarded.

Eligibility:

1. Students must be presenting a paper, of which they are the author or co-author, at the conference for which they are requesting funding to attend. This paper must be on a topic which falls under one of the Center's three program areas: 1) Developmental Transitions in a Changing World; 2) Poverty, Inequality, and the Human Condition; and 3) Science, Technology, and Society.

2. Students cannot receive an award if they have already been fully funded from another source.

Application Process:

Submit:

- a. Abstract of conference paper
- b. Proof of acceptance (i.e., conference program or letter of acceptance)
- c. Brief statement of relevance to at least one of the foci of the Center
- d. CV or resume
- e. Budget

Winter Quarter Deadline: Thursday, January 15, 2009
Spring Quarter Deadline: Wednesday, April 15, 2009
