

## Mentor Program Application FAQ Page

**Q: What should I include in my letter of interest?**

**A:** Your Letter of Interest (Cover Letter) should include:

- a. Reference to understanding of the Guidelines
- b. Indicate your career goals
- c. How the program will aid in your professional development
- d. Commitment to the program and to following up with your Mentor
- e. Other information you feel will assist in matching you with an appropriate mentor

**Q: Where can I find out what my responsibilities would be if accepted?**

**Q: By when will I be notified of my application status?**

**A:** No later than Friday, August 15, 2008.

**Q: Do I really need to submit my materials manually via snail mail?**

**A:** Yes. Unless you have notified Jennifer Gage of your extenuating circumstance which prevents you from mailing or hand delivering your materials, you are expected to submit your materials manually. If you email them without notice to Jennifer Gage, they will not be accepted.

**Q: If I am a second year applying to the program, will I be automatically accepted?**

**A:** No. Although preference is given to second years, it is still a competitive program, and not everyone who applies will be accepted.
